BARN AND ARENA RULES

- **Barn hours are from 8am to 7pm Monday through Sunday. No Haul in's on Sundays.**
- NO DOGS ALLOWED
- Absolutely no unsupervised young children allowed without parent or guardian.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must have adult supervision.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must wear a helmet.
- Boots with a heel are required for riding.
- No alcohol, drugs or profanity at the barn.
- Smoking is allowed in designated areas outside of the barn. Please put butts in the trashcans provided.
- **Cleanliness extremely enforced!**
- Keep barn tidy, please pick-up all garbage.
- Sweep cross tie area before leaving.
- Sweep aisle after exiting the arena and stalls. Also when bringing in your horse from outside paddocks, pastures, etc.
- Keep all barn doors closed after 4pm.
- Turn off the lights in the arena, cross tie area and the bathroom if you're the last one to leave the barn.
- Keep the wash rack clean. Clean the drain of hair and manure, there is a bucket, broom and shovel provided.
- No grooming or shoeing in the wash rack area.
- **Nobody rides unless a release form has been signed.**
- When entering the arena yell "**GATE!**" before entering and then proceed in cautiously.
- Mount in the center or in a safe area of the arena when others are riding.
- If the arena is in use and you are hand walking your horse, please stay to the inside.
- While riding in the opposite direction of another rider, you must pass left shoulder to left shoulder.
- Prescheduled riding lessons with trainers have priority with space in the arena.

BOARDER RULES

- Boarders are responsible for their own equipment, lockers are provided. Sharing of equipment is not encouraged.
- Management will do the feeding of boarded horses.
- Stalls will be cleaned by stall cleaners only, not horse owners.
- Keep records on your horse for worming and Vet recommended shots. EMR will also keep records on boarded horses and if they are not kept current you will be informed and have 1 week to take care of your horse's needs.
- Nothing on stall fronts unless approved.
- Halters must be buckled and hung on hook provided on stall.
- Blankets not being used must be hung up on designated stall #'s in the cross tie area. No storage for blankets.

CLINICS, SHOWS AND HAUL IN RULES

- Please have your hay pre-bagged for feeding, no loose hay.
- Clean up all loose hay and manure by your trailer before leaving.
